D6.7: Contribution to common H2020 activities in mutual agreement with EASME and to other EU initiatives

This task covers resources to contribute, upon invitation by the EASME, to common information (like reporting on impact indicators) and dissemination activities to increase synergies between, and the visibility of H2020 and European Commission supported actions.

The BIMplement consortium has proactively explored possibilities to connect with other H2020 Construction Skills projects.

Therefore, BIMplement joined the so-called BIM-Alliance (led by **BIMcert**), this together with NET-UBIEP, **BIMeet** and **BIMZEED** (Erasmus+).

The BIMplement training container concept from the France BIMplement partners is also applied in the recently started H2020 project **BUSLeague**. Several consortium partners will translate the concept of a mobile training unit including BIM-skills into their national context. This to replicate the successful intervention to train **BIMskills** in the daily work context (applied BIM).

Also in the latest call for proposals members of the BIMplement consortium cooperated in several new proposals. Building upon and extending BIMplement results.

For example, to use our findings on the importance of insight in the level of BIM-skills-maturity in a team, in order to organize proper upskilling and to prevent communication failures due to acting on different skill levels. Another example is the extension of BIMskills into the field of circularity; in order to sustain material value and therefore CO2-reduction

During his period, here are some of the main actions carried out.

BIMEET meeting

Brussels, 6th February 2018, organized by BIMEET *BIMEET workshop*.

- One representative of AVE was invited at this workshop to make a presentation of BIMplement and to look at potential cooperation.
- Two of the BIMEET members have connections with BIMplement: ISSO, which is member of both consortiums, and Mediaconstruct, which is member of the BIMplement french advisory Board.

- Potential synergies appeared with the project of « energy-bim. Community, and the offers of trainings... The outcome has been further discussed at the workshop meeting (see below)

Workshop “Building Information Modelling (BIM) skills & qualifications development”

Brussels, 26th June 2018, organized by EASME

- Representatives of the H2020 projects Net-UBIEP, BIMEET, BIMcert and BIMplement were invited to this contractors’ workshop organized by EASME.
- All of these projects are focused on the development of qualifications and training in BIM in order to enhance energy efficiency of buildings.
- The objective of the workshop was to explore possible synergies and complementarities among these four projects as well as to improve collaboration between the projects and partners involved.
